### Introduction

All through the year the Church family celebrates the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. This Annual Plan of Provision serves as a living document to represent the moments of encounter, in union with the lived experiences of our school community. Regular monitoring and evaluation will ensure that the plan remains relevant and effective in nourishing the spiritual lives of all those within the school community.

### Our School

St Benet Biscop aims to provide a wide ranging and holistic educational experience. Rooted in the Catholic tradition. We provide students with the values that will allow them to grow, develop and ultimately contribute to the communities in which they belong.

St Benet Biscop believe that every child has God given gifts and talents, and as a school community, we see it as our responsibility to ensure that these talents are nurtured, and that children flourish during their time with us. We aim to ensure that our students have a sense of belonging in our school community: that they feel like they have significance, and value, and that as a student body, they are all equal.

It is important to us that our students have a full and rounded spiritual and educational experience, with many opportunities to experience awe and wonder in the world, and to develop personally, morally on their spiritual journey.

The development of values shapes our student's character; to live a full life responding to God's calling and living out these values in positive daily actions through stewardship, this expands beyond school and the local community. It allows our students to be the person God intended them to be contributing to the common good and society.

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### **Advent**

*Advent is a season of preparation and anticipation for the celebration of Jesus' birth. We aim to create a peaceful and reflective atmosphere throughout the school to encourage students to embrace the spirit of waiting and hope.*

*Colour Scheme: Our table outside of the hall and chapel are decorated. Purple symbolises royalty, penitence, and preparation, reflecting our anticipation of the coming King.*

*Advent Wreath: The Advent wreath is a central focus in the school hall. This is used every morning during celebration of the word.*

*Music: Advent carols and hymns become a focus in our choirs, assemblies, and prayer times.*

*Students are given the opportunity in class to further explore prayer and reflections important to them during from time*

*The school chapel is open for quiet reflection with ambient music and small structured activities to guide students' journey though advent.*

### **Ordinary Time**

*Ordinary time is the longest liturgical season, offering us a time for growth and deepening our faith. We celebrate the ongoing presence of Christ in our lives and strive to live out the gospel message in our daily actions.*

### **Classroom and School Environment**

*Colour Scheme: Our table outside of the hall and chapel are decorated. We use green fabrics and decorations to symbolise spiritual growth and new life.*

*Mary Garden: The school prayer garden becomes a central focus during Ordinary Time.*



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*We encourage students to spend time in the garden, observing the natural world and connecting it to their spiritual growth.*

*Students are given the opportunity in class to further explore prayer and reflections that are important to them during from time, linked to significant liturgical days and wider world themes.*



*The school chapel is open for quiet reflection with ambient music and small structured activities to guide students journey their spiritual journey.*

### Lent

*‘Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.’*

*Philippians 4:6*

*Lent is a season of reflection, repentance, and renewal. We journey with Jesus towards the cross, reflecting on our own need for forgiveness and striving to deepen our relationship with God.*

*Colour Scheme: Our table outside of the hall and chapel are decorated. We use purple or violet fabrics and decorations to symbolise penance and preparation. Create a prayerful atmosphere.*

*Stations of the cross- Classes in RE will partake in stations of the cross. All students are invited to take part in a photography competition to create a contemporary version of ‘stations of the cross’ for our chapel.*

*During lent all form classes engage in a creative task of designing something to display in the school hall which will remain until our final celebration of the word before the Easter break. This year we will focus on ‘transformation’ and students will create a display of butterflies including scripture and prayers about how lent and Easter can transform us.*

*Morning Prayer: Begin each day with a special Lenten prayer. Focus on themes of repentance, forgiveness, and turning back to God.*

*Shared Prayer: Provide opportunities for shared prayer and reflection. Encourage students to examine their conscience and seek God's forgiveness.*



*The school maintains a sense of calm reverence and reflection throughout Lent. Children are encouraged to engage in the Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.*

### **Section 3 – Description and rationale of provision**

When we look at more formal gatherings, such as celebrations of the word and the variety of opportunities to experience prayer and liturgy in school, we must look at the structure of each day, week and term so that we can embed the seasons into the experiences of our community. Most importantly, we need to be deliberate and purposeful in shaping the structure of prayer and liturgy so that it is in harmony with the liturgical year and is engaging and accessible as possible.

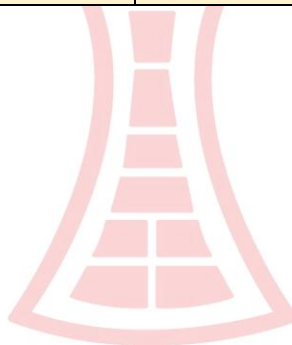

## Section 5 – Evaluation and monitoring

All prayer and liturgy is evaluated to ensure that our offer is quality assured. The quality assurance of prayer and liturgy follow wider school processes, this includes but is not limited to

- Celebration of word quality assurance each half term, recorded on an online system called flourish
- Half termly review of flourish with subject lead RE and Headteacher to review patterns and action to develop provision
- Link meetings between Head teacher and Subject lead for RE every two weeks. Prayer and liturgy is a standing item.
- Class led celebration of the word quality assured each half term, recorded on an online system called flourish
- Review of prayer and liturgy policy and annual plan of provision carried out by Headteacher and Subject Lead RE
- Student voice- Part of wider online surveys and group conversations
- Student voice- via form rep and Rise role model leadership groups
- Values - tally box pop up events held every 4 weeks

## Section 6 – Inclusive practice

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### Scripture

Using suitable translations, such as GNT, alongside accompanying simpler texts, pictorial resources, videos, music, and visual aids (e.g. Widgeits) allows us to remove any barriers to accessing the written word. Careful consideration will be given to scaffolding instruction for pupils in prayer and liturgy.

### Senses

Being mindful of the sensory and physical needs of our students will allow us to make adaptations where necessary. This will be discussed with pupils so that they have the relevant support and aids, so they can always feel comfortable and participate fully.

### Structure

Support is in place for both staff and students when planning celebration of the word. All form classes are given the opportunities to observe good practice, building confidence and sense of community.



## Section 7 – Other faiths provision

As a school, St Benet Biscop welcome everyone equally into our community; we ensure that our provision respects the diversity of our community.

### Respectful Dialogue and Consultation

When addressing the needs of students and staff from other faith traditions, the sources stress the importance of open and respectful dialogue with families and, where possible, local religious leaders. This allows the school to understand the perspectives and sensitivities of those involved and make informed decisions about appropriate levels of participation.

### Prioritising

Sensitivity and Integrity: It is considered inappropriate to ask individuals from other faith traditions to participate in liturgical actions or pronouncements that contradict their beliefs. This includes asking them to recite prayers that are Trinitarian in nature, make the sign of the cross, or read from Christian scriptures during formal prayer or liturgy.

### Creating Opportunities for Shared Reflection

While respecting the boundaries of liturgical participation, the sources encourage schools to create opportunities for shared reflection and prayer that acknowledge the common humanity and spiritual journeys of all individuals.
