What is Fair Trade?

The Fairtrade Foundation was established in 1992. Fairtrade is a way of buying and selling products that allows producers (farmers) to be paid a fair price for their produce and have better working conditions. Identified by the Fairtrade mark, products include both food and non-food items such as bananas, tea, coffee, chocolate and cotton.

What is fast fashion? It is cheap, trendy clothing that samples ideas from the catwalk or celebrity culture and turns them into garments in high street stores at breakneck speed to meet consumer demand. The idea is to get the newest styles on the market as fast as possible and then, sadly, discard them after a few wears. It forms a key part of the toxic system of overproduction and consumption that has made fashion one of the




